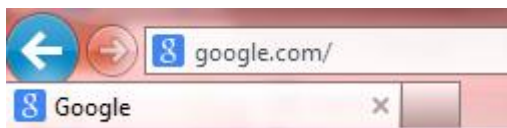
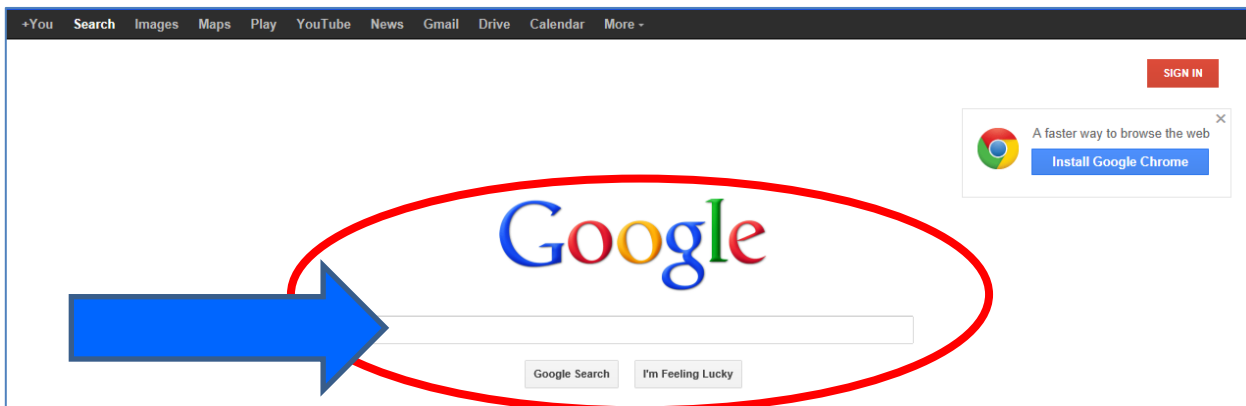


Turning ON Safe Search in Google:

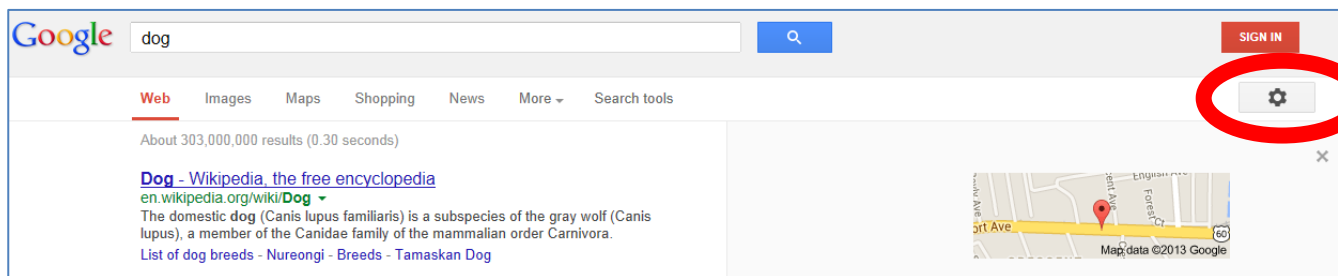
1. Begin by opening the Internet
2. Find the address bar at the top and type in **google.com** and click enter on your keyboard.



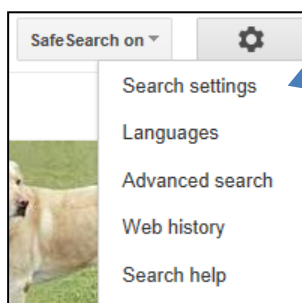
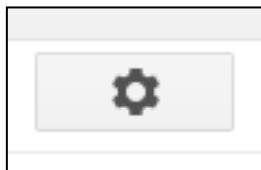
3. Google's website should come up like the picture below:



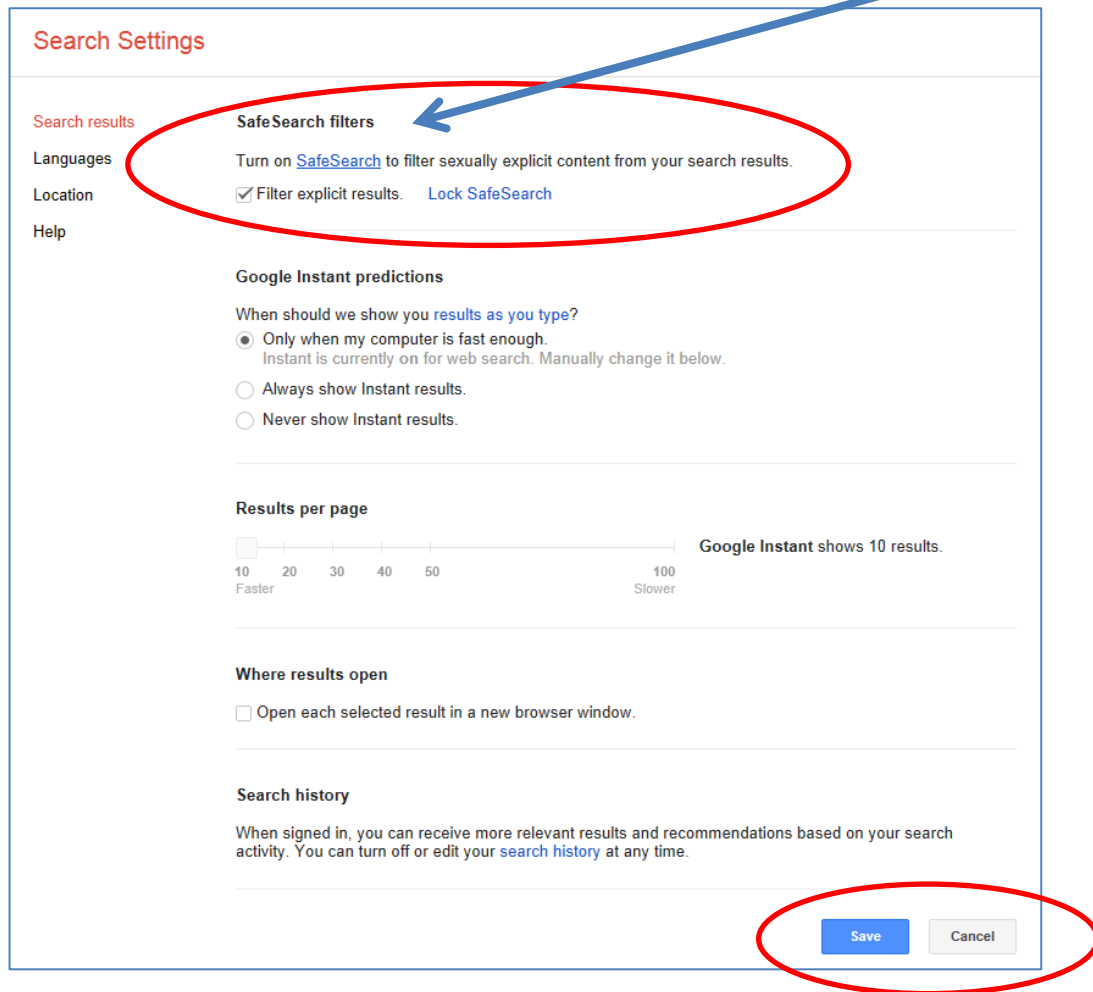
4. In the search bar underneath the word Google, type the word "dog" and click enter on your keyboard. You will get a page of website links, pictures, possibly a map or videos.



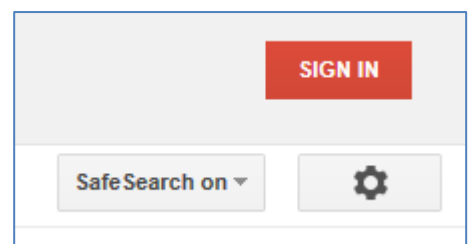
5. After you typed in the word "dog," you need to turn on SAFE SEARCH so you can get rid of any possible inappropriate (explicit) pictures or websites.
6. Find the **gear** picture to the **right** below the red "sign in" button. Click on the picture of the gear. You should see five choices. Click on the first choice – "**Search settings**".



7. In order to turn ON Safe Search, you will want to click on the empty box beside the word **“FILTER explicit results”** to put a checkmark in that box. Once that box is checkmarked, click on the BLUE Save button at the bottom.



8. Once you click SAVE, you are turning on Safe Search. If you look to the right of your screen by the gear, the **Safe Search ON** button is now there. This allows your teacher (or parent) to see that safe searching is on.



9. For Parents or Teachers: To turn OFF safe search, click on the GEAR again, and click **TURN OFF Safe Search**.
